How do you bid this Hand?

NORTH 9 109 QJ1097652 K2

You have a 6-Loser hand. Looked at the other way, no matter how the Diamonds break, you will make 6 Tricks, and CK is a chance for an extra one

But you are Vul and EW are not

It is too strong to Pass. Your options seem to be 3D or 4D (or even a cheeky 1D)

I prefer 3D, given the Vulnerability

The Bidding was:

(1) Doubling to show a strong Hand is better

(2) West does not know how strong East is

DQ was led. Knowing North had at least 7 Diamonds, East drew Trumps by finessing South for SQ

MORAL OF THE STORY

There are 2 morals to this story:

- 1. North should not get too excited about the 8-Card Diamond suit. He only needs to go down 3 Doubled = 800, a very expensive opening bid
- 2. East should Double over 3D, that way West knows East is strong (4C is just an overcall, could be weak given they are Not Vul)
